Arrival Times: 6 pm to 9 pm, Thursday, Sept. 5th.

Departure Times: after 6 pm, Saturday, Sept. 7th. No trucks will be allowed on the grounds before 6 pm.

Rules:

- Number of entries per class: one (1) per exhibitor.
- 4-H animals may be entered in the Open show. Use the Open Livestock Entry Form, entry fees apply.
- Livestock must have been the registered property of the exhibitor for at least 30 days prior to entry.
- Cattle must be in good health, and free from ringworm, parasites and skin diseases.
- Registered papers and health certificates must be produced on demand (see Health Requirements under Livestock Entries, Rules & Regulations).
- 3-Day Exhibitor's Pass:** \$17. The regular gate entry fee for adults is \$10 to \$12 per day.
