Rules:

- a. One entry per exhibitor per class. Exception: Machine Knitting – up to two entries/exhibitor/class.
- b. All entries must be the sole work of the exhibitor and must have been completed within the last 2 years.
- c. Where there is a definite class for an article, that item must be exhibited in that class. The chairperson may move exhibits to the correct class.
- d. Optional - include the following on a 3” x 5” card: pattern name and source, type(s) of yarn and type of construction. Attach the card to the entry tag.
- e. The chairperson reserves the right to refuse to display any exhibit that is unfinished, soiled, or in an obviously damaged condition.
- f. Exhibitors may purchase a 3-day pass for \$17. The regular gate fee for adults is \$10 to \$12 per day.

Section 2: Machine Knitting

Each exhibitor may enter up to two entries per class.

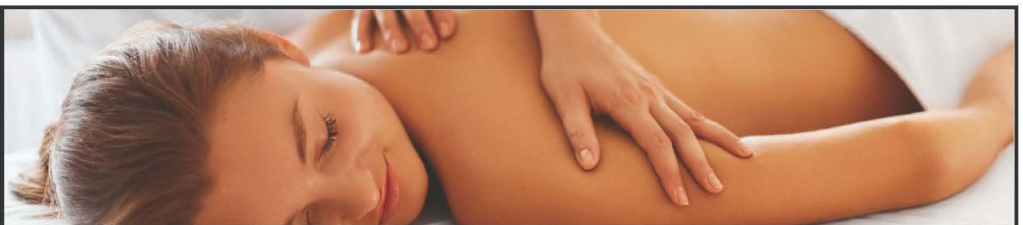
