Section 1: Sewing

Class

- 2019 Colour Challenge: Black & White – pillow

- Blouse, shirt, sweatshirt, T-shirt, vest, sleepwear
- Skirt, pants, slacks or jeans for adult or child
- Dress for adult or child. **Special prize: gift basket from Fabricland, Duncan.**
- Special occasion garment (e.g. wedding, graduation, costume) or original design garment. **Prize money donated by Anonymous.**
- Jacket, coat or suit
- Home accessory. **1st - \$5 . . . donated by Rosemary Kennedy.**
- Stuffed toy
- Dressed doll (doll can be bought or made) – outfit must be sewn work, no hot glue

Section 2: Senior Sewing (65 & over)

Seniors may enter the above Open Sewing classes in addition to the ones listed below.

Class

- Home accessory
- Garment for adult or child

Rules:

- One entry per exhibitor per class.
- Where there is a definite class for an article, that item must be exhibited in that class. The chairperson may move any exhibits entered in the wrong class.
- Entry to have been completed within the last 2 years.
- Optional - include the following info on a 3” x 5” card: pattern name and source, type(s) of fabric used, and information regarding the construction process. Attach the card to the entry tag.
- The chairperson reserves the right to refuse to display any exhibit that is unfinished, soiled, or in an obviously damaged condition.
- Exhibitors may purchase a 3-day pass for \$17. The regular gate fee for adults is \$10 to \$12 per day.
