

Rules & Regulations – HALL

Please read carefully.

These Rules & Regulations apply to all Hall Divisions unless noted otherwise under a Division's rules.

ENTRIES IN GENERAL

- a. 2019 Theme: "Milk & Cookies".
- b. 2019 Colour Challenge: Black & White
- c. All entries must be made out on the appropriate Exhibition form (photocopies acceptable) and must be accompanied by the entry fees. Please ensure that the exhibitor's name, telephone and address are correct.
- d. Entry fees can be paid by cash (CDN \$), debit or credit card, money order, bank draft or acceptable cheque made out to 'Cowichan Exhibition'.
- e. Bring or mail entry forms and fees to the Office: Cowichan Exhibition, 7380 Trans Canada Hwy, Duncan, BC V9L 6B1.
- f. Entries will not be accepted via telephone, fax or e-mail.
- g. The Exhibition reserves the right to limit entries if the number of entries exceeds the space available.
- h. No entry fees will be refunded on cancelled entries.

HALL ENTRIES

- a. Exhibitors may purchase a 3-day Exhibitor Pass for \$17 when delivering their entry forms. **Limit: 1 per exhibitor.** Single day passes (adults) are available for \$10-\$12/day.
- b. There are two registration deadlines: Saturday, Aug. 24th and Friday, Aug 30th, 2019. Please check the information at the beginning of whatever Division(s) you wish to enter to see which date applies.
- c. Entry fee is \$1 per exhibit. No late entries.
- d. No exhibit shown in a previous Cowichan Exhibition can be entered a second time.
- e. All exhibits must have been completed or grown by the exhibitor in the past two years.
- f. Except where specified in a Division or Section, an exhibitor cannot enter more than one exhibit per class.
- g. The age of a child is as of January 1 of the current year.
- h. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to enter the correct class. If any entry is obviously in the wrong class, it will be relocated at the discretion of the Division's Chairperson.
- i. If possible, tags for Hall Exhibits will be issued when the entry fee is paid. Please make sure you have picked up your tags prior to the delivery deadline.
- j. All entries must be labeled or tagged and delivered on one of three deliver dates (August 24th, September 3rd, September 5th). **Please see each Division for its specific delivery date and time.**

- k. Exhibitors must report to the Division Chairperson before leaving their entries on a display table.
- l. Only Division judges and designated Exhibition volunteers will be permitted in Mellor Hall during judging.
- m. The Exhibition will not be responsible for items left after 6 pm on Sunday and cannot be held liable for any loss.
- n. All food exhibits not picked up by 6 pm, Sunday, Sept. 8, 2019, will be disposed of. Any Hall exhibits remaining after Friday, Sept. 13, 2019, will be donated to a thrift shop.

HALL PRIZE MONEY

- a. Any exhibitors removing exhibits before 4 pm on Sunday will forfeit their prize monies.
- b. Prize money will be available for pick up at the Exhibition Office from September 23-27, from 9-5.
- c. Prize money donated to the Exhibition is appreciated.
- d. Any exhibitor who violates any general or specific Division Rule shall forfeit any or all prize money and any awards made to them.

JUDGING AND DISPUTES

- a. The Judge's decision(s) will be final.
- b. No person shall be allowed to act as a judge if he is in any way financially interested in the exhibits.
- c. Chairpersons are not to judge their own Divisions.
- d. Judges are not obligated to award any prize if the exhibit does not merit it. **A SINGLE ENTRY IN A CLASS DOES NOT GUARANTEE A PRIZE.**
- e. All Hall class protests must be made in writing, must state plainly the nature of complaint, and must be delivered with a deposit of \$25 to the Exhibition Office by 6 pm, Friday, Sept. 6, 2019.
- f. The deposit will be forfeited if the protest is not sustained. The Exhibition's Board of Directors shall be the final judge of all protests.
